

# WADHURST PARISH COUNCIL

## POSTER DISPLAY POLICY, JARDIN D'AUBERS

1. Wadhurst Parish Council provides an area of fence alongside the pond on the Eastern edge of the Jardin d'Aubers. This is available for the use of community groups to display posters, at the discretion of the Parish Clerk.
2. The affixing of any poster must be agreed in advance by the Parish Clerk, who may, at her discretion, withhold such agreement.
3. The space is only available for community organisations based in Wadhurst, for activities happening in and around Wadhurst.
4. It is not available for advertising by commercial organisations, political groups, organisations based outside Wadhurst (though in exceptional circumstances this may be agreed by the Chair of the Community Committee) or religious organisations advertising religious events (though the advertising of events such as jumble sales, concerts etc. is allowed)
5. Only spaces along the fence may be used for advertising – the placing of advertising material elsewhere in the Jardin can create hazards for users.
6. Posters may be affixed up to 3 weeks before the event, and must be removed immediately afterwards.
7. When posters are removed, the backing boards they are placed on must be removed at the same time, or the space quickly starts to look untidy.
8. No poster should be placed in a way which obscures another poster.
9. Any posters which contravene this policy will be removed. They will be kept for 28 days so they can be collected by the organisation posting them, after which time they will be destroyed.
